## Traffic flow for our school



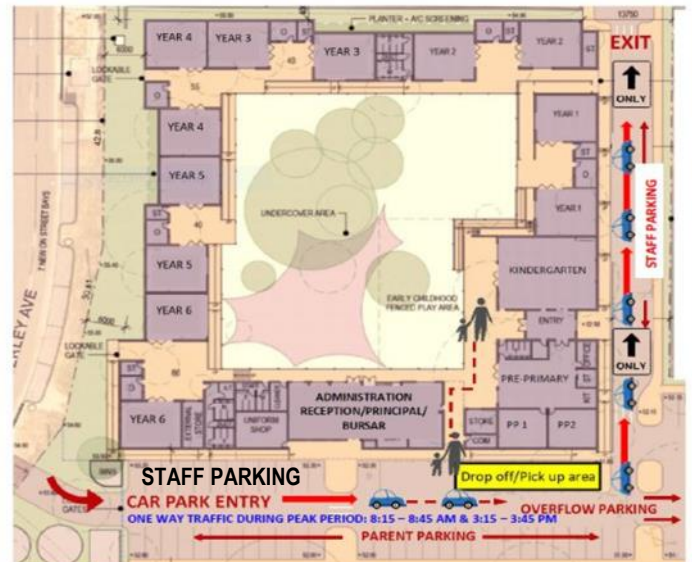
Please follow the instructions of staff members on duty.
