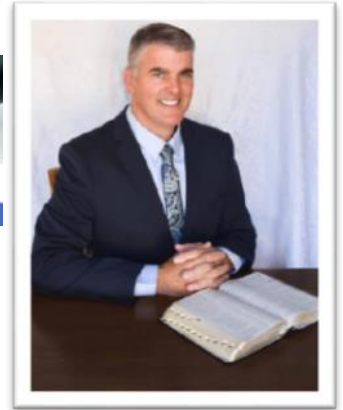

Principal's Message



Dear Parents and Guardians

I trust and pray you have been able to enjoy a break from the normal school routine and are looking forward to the start of Term 4. This is a shortest term of the school year but it is full of many activities as we prepare for the end of the year reporting period as well as take time to finish the year well.

As I reflect on all that has been accomplished this year and look ahead at what is planned for the remainder of the year, especially in the lead up to Christmas, I am reminded that we trust in a God that gives us the power, grace and strength to help us finish well.

The Bible tells us that God always finishes what he starts:

"God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished" (Philippians 1:6 NLT).

It doesn't say, "God might finish it." It doesn't say, "God hopes to finish it." It says God will finish it.

It means if we have really given our life to Jesus Christ — if we have really opened ourselves up to God and said, "Jesus, be number one in my life" — we are going to make it to heaven. The only question is how we finish the race.

He wants us to enjoy life, an abundant, flourishing life — to figure out what God made us for and then to simply do it. He wants us to finish well.

Sustaining grace is the power to keep on going when you feel like giving up. It's the power to do the right thing when you don't feel like doing the right thing. It is a supernatural, God given power that is often described as the power of the Holy Spirit.

There are many pitfalls in the marathon race of life. However, regardless of what we go through, no matter what we face, we can count on God's sustaining grace. We can put our trust in Him.

I trust and pray that you have a blessed start to Term 4 as we look forward to finishing together the 'race set before us'.

SCHOOL START/FINISH TIMES

The morning bell rings at 8:30 AM and all students are expected to line up immediately at their FORM CLASS. They should be at school at least 5 minutes before the bell, but not before 8:15 AM as the staff have their devotions during this time. **Late students without a parent note with a valid reason are given 3 warnings before they are given detention. Parental interviews with the Principal will be required for those who continually arrive late at school.** The daily timetable is based on 6 x 55 minute periods.
